# Sri S.P. Sampathy Founder Siva Sivani Group of Institutions

The eldest son of Sri Shivraj Sampathy and Smt. Lakshmi Devi, Sri S.P. Sampathy was born on Saturday, the 22<sup>nd</sup> of October 1927. He had a brief stint as an 'A' class Civil Contractor and then a Police Officer in the state of Andhra Pradesh. The first school of the Siva Sivani Group was started on Thursday the 3<sup>rd</sup> of August 1961 at 9, Czech Colony, Sanathnagar, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh with 6 students on its rolls. The school was initially named The English Preparatory School and was subsequently renamed as Siva Sivani Public School. In 1978 a branch was opened at Somajiguda which was shifted to Road No. 13, Banjara Hills in 1980. From school education the group forayed into higher education when permission to start the Siva Sivani Institute of Management at Kompally was secured on the 9th of December, 1992. The SPS High School was started on the 31st January 2001. The Siva Sivani Degree College, affiliated to the Osmania University was started in 2003 though the permission was obtained in 2002 itself. The Sivani Junior College was started in the year 2016. Permission to run the Fellowship Program at Siva Sivani Institute of Management was obtained in 2021 with which Siva Sivani Group of Institutions attained the landmark of offering education from nursery to Doctoral studies on the same campus at Kompally, fulfilling a long cherished dream of its illustrious Founder.

Sri S.P. Sampathy left this mortal world on Friday, the 11th of February 2005.
